Membership Renewal in 2017

Hopefully you all have renewed your membership by now. If not you will need to do so before April 1st. We have automated the membership renewal process through the new Gamelines website and we hope this new process makes it easier for you to renew. For those who have not yet renewed, you should have received a reminder in the mail. If you disregarded that reminder, consider this your final reminder. As of April 1st, the system will show you as an expired member at which time you will still be able to login to renew for another 30 days. Your membership will be **dropped** and any work day credit will be removed if renewal is not received by May 7th.

Work Days – Range Cleanup and Rebuild

While we do have focused cleanup days each spring, please do your part throughout the year to keep the range clean of trash, broken arrows, etc. If we all follow the “pack it in, pack it out” philosophy on the range it will make the shooting experience that much better for everyone.

Saturday May 6th will be a work day focused on clearing trees and cleaning up the range. Having cleaned up most of the A loop and part of the B loop last year, we will primarily focus on the B and C loops this year. Sunday May 7th will be the general work day focused on target maintenance and replacement. Last fall we took advantage of an opportunity to purchase 4 new targets, including a standing elk and a large “Hogzilla.” During the spring work day we will add a “Buck Palace” Redneck ground blind. This will provide members with the new opportunity to sharpen their hunting skills out of a darkened ground blind. The blind will be placed just south of the current treestand, on a spot that was already cleared during last spring’s work day.
